

KEELS & WHEELS BOAT CLASSES

The classes are defined by ACBS guidelines as of November 2015

Historic - built before 1919

Antique - 1919 to 1942

Classic – 1943 to 1975

Late Classic – 1976 to 1990

Contemporary – A Wooden boat built within the past 25 years

Custom - modified or one of a kind (any year)

Classic Glass – to 1989 only

Replica - built as a copy of any production type boat (any year)

The classes below will be used as the primary guideline in determining the classes used for judging. Classes may be added or expanded to more accurately reflect the actual entries received, i.e. size of boat, manufacturer, etc.

Definitions:

1. A Runabout includes an inboard engine, with the engine decked over.
2. A Utility includes an inboard engine with removable box over the engine
